PGC Range Report:

Here is a list of the work done by the city since January.

1. Worked on the berms at the action pistol range.
2. Replace the rams at the all-purpose and silhouette ranges.
Repaired the other metal targets and replacing the celotex on the target boards.
3. Made a road along the back fence to make repairing the fence easier.
The last repairs seem to be holding.
4. The new cleanup crew is doing a better job on Thursdays.
5. The covered pistol range will be available for conceal instructional classes.
At this time if you get a permit it is for the whole covered range.
There are 3 bays and each bay will be permitted separately.

Range Goals for 2018:

- * Maintain the berms at all the ranges
- * Put up steel targets at the 1000 and 600 yds.
- * Put railroad ties in front of the rails at the Silhouette range
- * Maintain the berms in back and front of the target boards
- * Finish paving the road at the Silhouette range and repairing the rest of the road
- * Safety and Procedure signs at all the ranges
- * Repaint the shooting benches and platform. Replace the carpet on the rifle rests.
- * Put in additional shooting benches at the Silhouette range
- * Put crusher fine in front of the sidewalk at the silhouette range.
- * Finish repairing the cattle guard
- * Clean up glass and shotgun shells
- * Other repairs and maintenance as needed
